2 months	WCC, Pentacel ² , Hep B, Prevnar, Rotavirus-OR- Pediarix ³ , Hib, Prevnar, Rotavirus
4 Months	WCC, Pentacel, Hep B ⁴ , Prevnar, Rotavirus-OR- Pediarix, Hib, Prevnar, Rotavirus
6 Months	WCC, Pentacel, Hep B, Prevnar, Rotavirus ⁵ -OR- Pediarix, Hib, Prevnar, Rotavirus
9 Months	WCC, Review Immunization Status
12 Months	WCC, MMR, Varicella, HepA
15 Months	WCC, HIB, Prevnar
18 Months	WCC, DTaP, Hep A
2 Years	WCC, MMR/Varicella (ProQuad)
3 Years	WCC, Review Immunization Status
4 Years	WCC, DTaP/IPV (Kinrix)
5 Years-10 Years	WCC, Review Immunization Status
11-12 Years	WCC, Tdap, Menactra, Gardasil
13 Years-15 Years	WCC, Review Immunization Status, catch up Hep A
16-18 Years	WCC, Menactra, consider Meningitis B
19 and Older	Adult PE, Review Immunization Status

- Flu Vaccine at any WCC if due and in season
- Hemoglobin and lead screening at 12 and 24 months
- Regular interval evaluations of the following: hemoglobin screen, development and/or mental health questionnaires, vision and hearing screening
- Other testing as indicated by provider assessment

²Pentacel = IPV< DTaP, HIB

³Pediarix = IPV< DTaP, Hep B

⁴Hep B needed only if birth dose was not given

⁵Third dose needed if Rotateq previously given
